Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by Will Lavery at 6:30 with eight members, and five officers in attendance. See the attached attendance sheet.

The June 2025 meeting minutes were approved and no one proposed that they be read.

Training & Safety Report: Steve Spielbusch reported that Rodney Nance and Trevor Mcendree soloed earning their flying permits. Steve wanted to make everyone aware of a mid-air collision that took place last Saturday. Steve suggests that anyone that wants to fly acrobatics, must inform by calling it out **loud** when taking off. The other suggestion was that all acrobatics be performed within the center of the flying pattern. The flying pattern is a large rectangle and all acrobatics should be performed inside that rectangle.

The Training & Safety report was approved.





Field Maintenance: The grass continues to grow and cutting will continue on a weekly basis. The infield area was treated with two bags of insect poison to kill ticks.

The Field Maintenance Report was approved.

Old Business

Will Lavery confirmed that the Swap-N-Shop is scheduled for December 6th from 7AM to 2PM at the Lenexa Old Town Activity Center 9301 Pflumm Rd, Lenexa, KS 66215. The attending membership voted to add electric outlets to the posts on the east side of the pavilion. These will be four socket outlets that will serve as overflow charging stations. Powers strips will be provided on the eastmost table and stored in the shed to be used as needed.

Terry repaired it to flying condition and transformed it from gas to electric. Terry used a 480KV motor with a 100-amp ESC running on a 6 cell 5000 ma battery.
