Meeting Minutes

Training & Safety Report: Steve Spielbusch reported that training continues even though the weather is very hot. No one has soloed this month but there are a few trainees that are getting close. Steve also mentioned that everyone needs to pay attention and call out when a plane is headed for the side of the field where people are. Will Lavery alerted everyone that we have had two people get cut by propellers that needed medical attention. We now have a first aid station at the front of the shed complete with gauze, tape and scissors. The closest emergency room that I could find to our field is The University of Kansas Health System Urgent Care, KU MedWest, Medical Pavilion, 7405 Renner Rd Level 2, Shawnee, KS 66217. It was noted that everyone makes sure that you configure and use the throttle cut feature on your radios.

The Training & Safety report was approved.

Field Maintenance: John Baker reported that the grass continues to grow at a rate that requires a weekly cutting. We have four individual that cut the grass and more volunteers can cut down on these four having to cut every week. Get in touch with John Baker if you want to cut the field grass once in a while.
